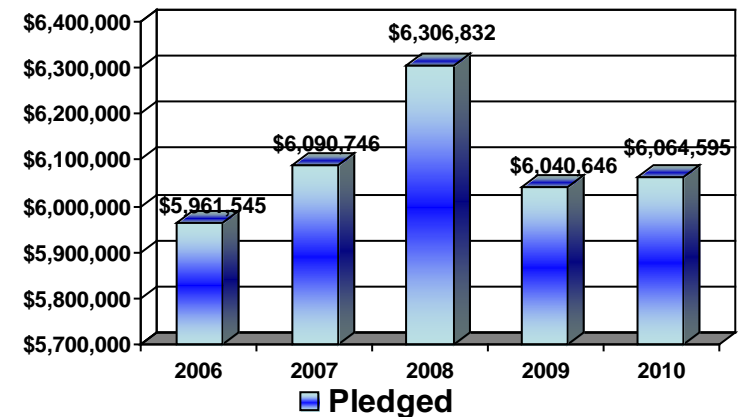
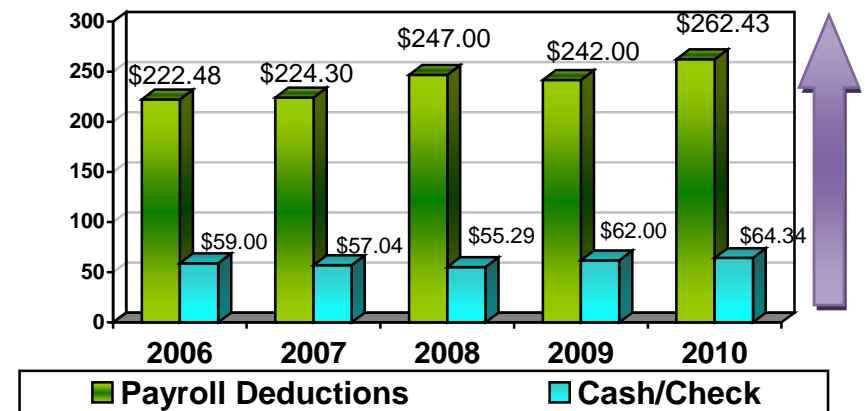

A DONOR IS ABLE TO SPREAD HIS OR HER GIFT OVER THE ENTIRE YEAR. LAST YEAR, 70% OF ALL CFC FUNDS WERE GIVEN THROUGH PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS. PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS BEGIN IN JANUARY AND CONTINUE THROUGH DECEMBER. 29,898 DONORS IN 2010 GAVE AN AVERAGE GIFT OF \$202.84. PAYROLL DEDUCTION AND CASH AVERAGES ARE SHOWN IN THE CHART BELOW. THE PER CAPITA CONTRIBUTION WAS \$71.34.
